VENUE BOOKING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Bookings are confirmed on receipt of the deposit payment.

This deposit is to secure the date and pay for 6 hours of time with the Sound Engineer. This includes sound checks and set times. Any additional hours/over-runs are charged at £16.50 PH and are paid directly to the sound engineer.

Additional payments must be paid within 5 days of the event.

Cancellations that result in the venue forfeiting an event will not be refunded.

All Artwork, Ticket Links, Artist bios and Tags and Event Information should be forwarded to the venue 4 weeks before the event date, or at the earliest possible time.

It is the promotor's responsibility to provide their own door-person to check tickets and take door money.

A Sum-Up Card Reader can be loaned from the bar (£10 deposit)

All drinks consumed on the premises must be purchased at the bar.

No Alcoholic or Soft drinks may be brought in to the premises. Without exception.

In the instance where a rider has been agreed with the management, the promotor is responsible for the purchase of the rider, and drinks will be kept behind the bar. The promotor will be given tickets to exchange for the agreed rider.

The Venue undertakes to provide a safe working environment. All those providing their own sound and electrical equipment shall ensure that they hold the relevant safety documentation for the equipment they provide.

The Venue, Promotor and all Acts performing on the premises agree to respect at all times the confidentiality of the business of all parties relating to this engagement and that he/she/they will not engage in any public pronouncements that may be detrimental to the reputation of the Venue, Venue Staff & Management, Promotor or Performers.

Such 'public pronouncements' include, but are not limited to Instagram, Twitter, Facebook and all other such social media sites.

The Venue is strictly 18+ after 7pm, Guests, Artists and Ticket holders should be advised that they may be asked to show I.D on entry and/or at the bar.

The Venue reserves the right to cancel events at any point, if it deems they are offensive, inappropriate or damaging to the business.
